


PCN WORSHIP ON ZOOM GUIDE

Friends, I hope that you all are well!


You do not need a Zoom account to participate in worship. In order to connect, you can click on the link you are provided and you will be automatically connected into the meeting. If you prefer not to use your computer, and join by phone only, you'll need to dial in the phone number and then enter in the Meeting ID #. Please note that due to increased use, Zoom has advised direct dialing using the phone may not be totally reliable.

Once you are connected to the Zoom meeting, there are a couple of important icons on the bottom left of your screen:



If you have an integrated camera in your computer, you can click on the “Start Video” icon and the camera will turn on, and the red slash line will disappear. If you click on the “Join Audio” icon, you’ll be able to set your audio controls – either by using your computers speakers and microphone or, if you have a headset, you can select that device. If you see a red slash line on your audio icon, that means you are on mute and no one can hear you. Click on the icon again to come off of mute – REMEMBER that if you are off mute, everyone can hear background noise. Best practice is to leave yourself on mute when you are not talking so that background noise is minimized. If you don’t want to try and toggle on/off mute, while you are on mute you can press your space bar and you will be temporarily off mute so that people can hear you.

In the bottom middle of your screen are two additional items that may be helpful:



The share icon allows you to share your screen (You will NOT need this). The CHAT icon is very helpful – if you click on that, a chat “window” will open up and you can type in comments and then post them for people to see. **You will use the CHAT ICON to type in Prayer Requests during the service.**

We will provide more helpful guidelines at the start of the service.
